Covid-19 Policy – 5th October 2021



Policy

The Board of The Embroiderers Guild, Victoria values all members of the Guild. It is important to act responsibly and transparently for the benefit of all members of the community.

This policy aims to protect the membership of the Guild and provide a safe community environment for members and non-members to enjoy Guild activities.

The Embroiderers Guild, Victoria requires members and non-members entering Embroidery House for work, classes, or other events, to be fully vaccinated. Evidence of vaccination status or medical exemption, must be provided prior to attending Guild classes or when entering Embroidery House.

This policy applies to Branches of The Embroiderers Guild, Victoria. Branches of The Embroiderers Guild, Victoria must also comply with the Covid regulations in effect at their relevant venues.

Implementation

Members and non-members will follow all Covid protocols in accordance with the Government guidelines. These will be routinely updated.

- check in with QR code.
- follow directions given by Covid monitors, monitors will be trained in the required protocols.
- hand sanitising, hand sanitisers will be placed at the entrances to any venue.
- ensure good air flow by opening doors in the venue and opening windows and/or using air conditioning.
- wear face masks, ensuring that the face is appropriately covered.
- work stations must be configured to comply with social distancing requirements.
- clean work surfaces at the end of sessions, cleaning products will be provided.
