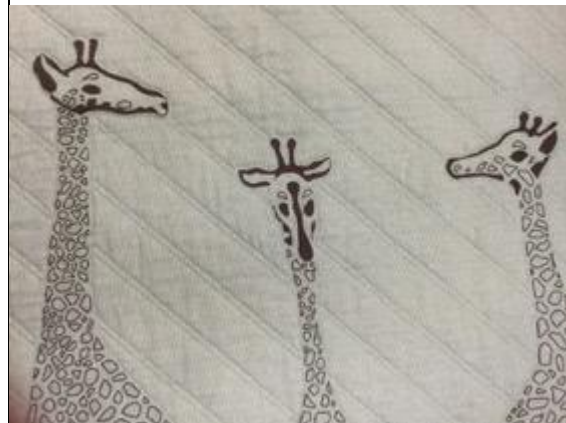


The Embroiderers' Guild, Mildura Branch – April 2, 2018 Photos

Ann Morrish diligently continues work on her large, intricate, long-term project; her 1-inch hexagon quilt in a multitude of colours.







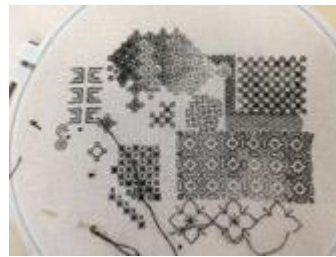

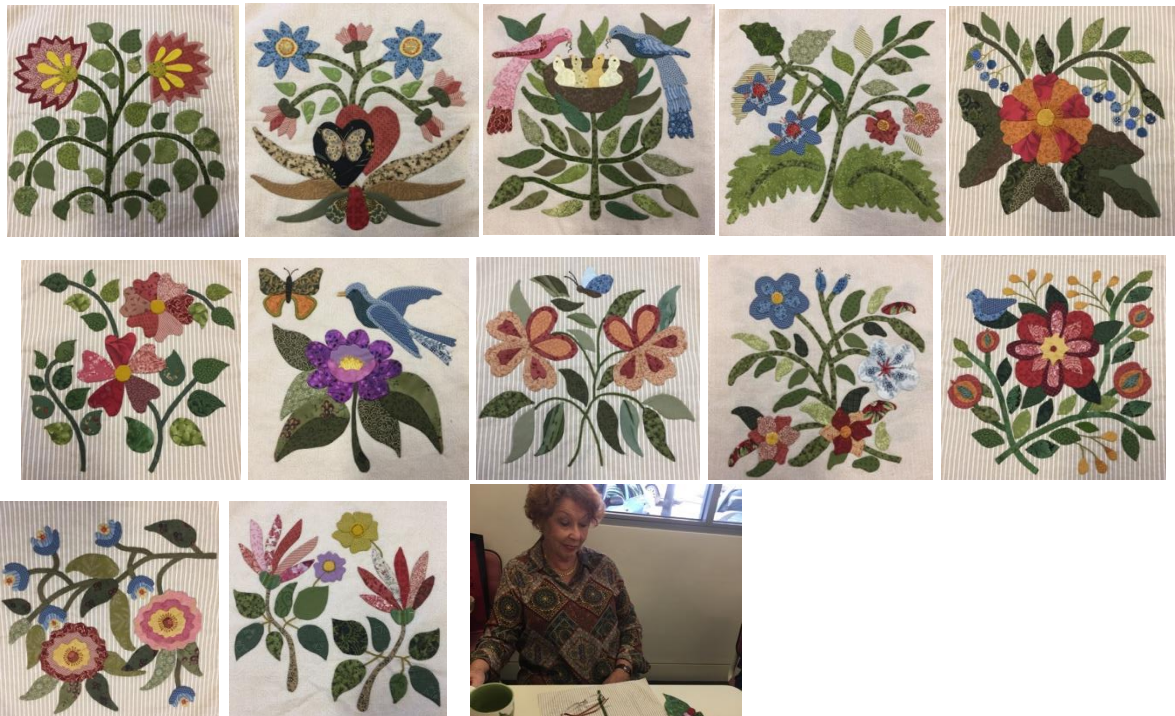
