"DIAMONDS IN THE SKY"

Every Guild member Statewide is invited to make one or more embroidered fabric "diamonds" for our "Diamonds in the Sky" display in the gallery during our Diamond Jubilee Year in 2020. The more the better! The colourful diamonds will be strung together and hung down from the rafters in the Gallery of Embroidery House. Each diamond MUST BE 15cm high and 10cm wide when finished (6"x4"). They are to be either embroidered/stitched/collaged or beaded on both sides (no felt please) and stiffened with vylene or cardboard in the centre. You might like to stitch the number 60 in the centre?? Edges should be finished with either satin stitch, buttonhole stitch or zig-zag. We would like them to be made in jewel colours of Saphire Blue, Ruby Red, Emerald Green, Turquoise, Amber Gold and Diamond White, or a combination of these colours. This would be a great fun project for your Branch or Guidance Group. Please return the finished "diamonds" to the office marked "Diamonds in the Sky" by November 30th, 2019. Happy stitching!
