



DONATIONS: By-laws

1. DONATIONS FROM THE GUILD: By-laws

- 1.1.** As per our constitution, all monies raised in the name of The Embroiderers Guild, Victoria may be used to benefit the Guild only. *Please also read the following information sheet concerning possible responses to donations to charities, or to disasters.*
- 1.2.** It follows that the Guild may donate items given by members to community groups, but these must not be paid for from Guild funds.
- 1.3.** The Board may approve cash amounts as sponsorship or prizes e.g RASV. Any sponsorship or prize must reflect the aims of the EGV.

2. DONATIONS OF GOODS OF VALUE TO THE GUILD: By-laws

- 2.1.** All donations received from the general public shall be listed in the Donations book and acknowledged in writing.
- 2.2.** All donations become the property of the Guild and the Board nominees will determine the destination of the goods.
- 2.3.** Valuable donations e.g. out-of-print publications, old embroideries, lace, needlework tools, if not required, shall be offered to a suitable institution in the first instance, then to members, and then to the public for sale/tender, at the discretion of the Board.
