Established in 1960, **The Embroiderers Guild, Victoria**, is a not-for-profit organisation with members throughout Victoria.

Our aims are to promote, teach and enjoy the art and skills of embroidery – traditional and contemporary. We are open to all from beginners to more experienced embroiderers.



Embroidery House, the Guild's Head Office in Malvern, is open 7 days a week - a friendly hub and resource centre for all members. It has a spacious Gallery, classrooms and an extensive library. It is also home to our significant collections of embroideries, lace and historic needlework tools.

Meetings, lectures, classes, exhibitions, monthly displays and guidance groups are held throughout the year, both at Embroidery House and at our Branches.

CLASSES: Members enjoy discounted fees on classes and workshops. Traditional and contemporary embroidery is taught from beginner to expert. More advanced courses are offered at Intermediate and Master Class levels in a variety of techniques, including Design. Classes are also run at our Branches throughout Victoria.

GUIDANCE GROUPS: Friendly groups meet at regular intervals in an informal atmosphere to create, learn and share embroidery skills and ideas. Check out the schedule for Embroidery House and the Melbourne metropolitan area, or with your local Branch.

LIBRARY: Our extensive library houses the largest collection of embroidery related books and magazines in Victoria. These are available to all members for both reference and borrowing. Branches also have libraries.

NEWSLETTER: *Threadlines* is distributed monthly and includes upcoming classes, Guild activities and articles of general interest.

EXHIBITIONS: The Annual Exhibition offers members the opportunity to exhibit their work in our spacious gallery. Special themed exhibitions are held from time to time, and Branches also hold their own exhibitions.

THE COLLECTION: Members have access to the Guild's outstanding collection of historical and contemporary embroideries, lace and historic needlework tools.

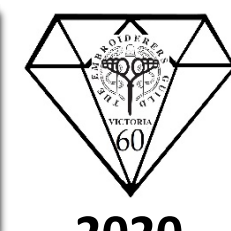

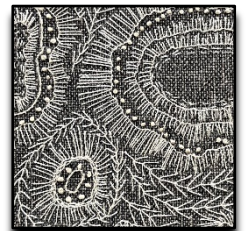
